A stack overflow vulnerability exists in the WebCam Server functionality of GeoVision GV-VMS V20.0.2, V17.4.8 and V18.3.5. A specially crafted HTTP request can lead to a arbitrary code execution. An attacker can make an unauthenticated HTTP request to trigger this vulnerability.

Resolution:

Reported vulnerabilities are resolved with GV-VMS V20.0.2.10, V17.4.8.58, V18.3.5.22 and later versions which are available to download from GeoVision's official download page at:
